On 8-9-13, R/O received a call from Coke County dispatch in reference to a vehicle parked partially on the shoulder and partially in the main lane of traffic. R/O located the vehicle, a male individual pulled up just prior to R/O arrival and said that the pickup belonged to his brother and that he was looking for him because he ran out of gas. R/O did not see anyone walking towards Bronte. The brother tried calling him back on the phone but could not reach him. The brother advised he had to be at work and that he would look for him on his way back to San Angelo. As of 8:00am on 8-9-13 no one had heard anything further from Brandon Lawson. The pickup was towed by the Best Connection Wrecker and stored in Robert Lee.

Narrative:

On 8-9-13, Coke County S.O. was contacted regarding the driver of the 2000 F150 towed from US 277 south of Bronte had not been heard or seen since running out of gas. His brother, Kyle Lawson, put some gas in the pickup and came back for him after 4am but did not find him.

Lawson's information was obtained later in the day, it was discovered that he has an outstanding warrant from Johnson County for possession of a controlled substance, and he has been in TDC numerous times for drugs.

Verizon was contacted about the missing person and was requested Lawson's cell phone information. Text messages showed that Lawson and his girlfriend were having a heated exchange. She was accusing him of doing drugs in front of their son and that he will not hurt her again. She put in the text that she was going to put gasoline on his clothes and that he will be going back to jail and the cops will be watching the house. His text to her consisted of calling her crazy and that the house was his. There were other texts to him from other people. Two that stood out was one that came to him before midnight offering him \$1500 to help him out and the last one at 1:18am telling him that the cops were at his truck. This was the last activity shown on Lawson's cell phone.

At 3:35pm, R/O met with Lawson's girlfriend at the rest area on 277 close to where the pickup was left. She said that she felt that he was out in the brush hurt and can't be found. R/O advised her that there were two calls that morning, one was to 911 about someone being out of gas and the second was about a stranded vehicle south of Bronte called in by a passing motorist. R/O was the officer that located the pickup just after Kyle Lawson arrived. This officer told her that Kyle was trying to get a hold of Brandon by phone and then told R/O that he did not see anybody walking towards San Angelo and that he had to be at work later so he left. She told R/O that something had to be wrong because it was not like Brandon to act like this. R/O asked her if he ever did drugs and she said that he has been clean for over a year and a half and does not do them anymore. R/O then told her about the felony warrant and that we were able to obtain the text that he has sent and received, which also covered their exchanges. She said that she did not feel that it was important to tell us everything and that they were aware of the warrant for some time. She then started saying that if he did anything, he was hallucinating and he thought that people were chasing him and did not know where he was. R/O told her that he knew enough to possibly call 911 about being out of gas and called his brother and told him where he needed gas.

On Saturday, 8-10-13 at approx. 5:30pm, R/O spoke with Kyle Lawson. Lawson told R/O that he was on the phone with his brother at the time that R/O arrived and the he told him to leave because he could see the cop car. When asked where he was, he said that he was hiding in the brush close to the roadway. He was afraid to tell R/O because he did not want his brother to go to jail and he did not have a driver's license himself and was in an unregistered vehicle. R/O informed him that this information would have been helpful when he spoke with the dispatcher in the afternoon the day before. R/O informed him that there was about 6 hours passed from the time that R/O was last at the vehicle and the time it was towed at 8:30am, that Brandon Lawson could have gone back to it or hitch-hiked a ride away from the area to avoid being arrested for the warrant. R/O made checks of houses where the residents were gone and found that nothing around those house have been disturbed, including signs that someone might have gotten water. That evening, R/O checked the same area with a thermal imaging camera. No heat signature close to the size of a human was seen under the cedar brush.

On Sunday, 8-11-13, a small private search party gathered at 8:00am in the Stripes parking lot. This group ended their search around noon. The only sign of anyone being in that area was a spot under a tree where it appeared someone sat down close to the roadway within eyesight of where Lawson's pickup broke down.

On 8-12-13, Texas Ranger Lt. Dwayne Goll, to meet with R/O and Sheriff McCutchen and a second private search party that was going to gather again. The search was called off and only two people that where friends with Ladessa showed up. She called saying that it was called off because a private pilot was going to donate an hour of flight time. Lt. Goll met with R/O and McCutchen and was updated on events. Lt. Goll came to the same conclusion of R/O and McCutchen that Lawson is possibly no longer in Coke County, but would see about making arrangements on the availability of a DPS helicopter.

On 8-13-13, Texas Ranger Nick Hanna contacted R/O that he would be coming into Coke County around noon with the helicopter. At 2:20pm, Ranger Hanna arrived onboard the helicopter with a TFO onboard. R/O briefed the TFO and the pilot on how long since Lawson had been heard from and the last known location. After flying over an area from the Colorado River south and along both sides of US 277 to where R/O located Lawson's pickup, it was determined that Lawson was not on the ground due to the fact that there was a lot of exposed bare ground even under the short mesquite and cedar bushes. R/O was flown back to the airstrip at Robert Lee and the aerial search ended.

R/O was able to obtain the video footage of the morning of 8-09-13, from the Stripes convenience store cameras. It showed that Kyle Lawson, along with his girlfriend and a large male with what appeared to be blond hair wearing a yellow shirt, parked in the south parking lot at 7:09am and stayed until 7:26am. They came back at 7:30am and a female got a red gas tank out of the trunk of the car and got fuel in it and returned. This red fuel can was in the back of the pickup at 8:30am.

It is in this officer's opinion that Brandon Lawson is not in Coke County, lost or hiding. R/O's opinion is based off of the conversation with Kyle Lawson about his brother hiding in the brush close to the roadway to avoid being discovered by officers. The text messages that he had with his

girlfriend leads one to believe that he was leaving and she threatened him with having cops watch the house and have him thrown in jail. He tried calling her three times when he ran out of gas, but she did not answer her phone. It is R/O's belief that after Kyle Lawson left and after R/O last checked on the Ford pickup driven by Brandon Lawson. Lawson walked back to the roadway and was able to get a ride from a passing motorist.

Narrative:

On 1-15-2022 at 3:07pm, R/O was contacted by Sheriff Wayne McCutchen to contact a Jason Watts about the Brandon Lawson case. McCutchen was contacted by a private investigator in Maryland by Watts, who believed that he might have found some property of Lawson's.

R/O contacted Watts. Watts told R/O that he had been conducting a search for Lawson on and along the south side of the Colorado River, and he believed that he found some shorts and shoes that matched the description of what Lawson was wearing at the time of his disappearance. The property that he was on is owned by Fred Garza and his brother and did advise that he had permission from Fred Garza.

R/O met with Watts at the gate to the property. This property is 2.3 miles south of the city limit of Bronte, with the gate located by the southeast end of the US 277 Colorado River Bridge. Watts said that the items were at some distance from the gate and would have to be accessed by foot once in the area that the items were located. Entering the property, R/O followed a trail that led to a deer blind where other cars and people were waiting. Once parked, Watts lead R/O down an animal trail through thorn brushes. The only visible trails on the property were several animal trails, any vehicle trails that had been on the property, have grown back over by grass and weeds.

Watts took R/O to the area that he said that the first shoe was found. He said that the shoes that Lawson was wearing were of the same brand and model found, Nike AirMax. R/O could see a degrading white sole to a shoe with Max imprint still visible. This was photographed and labeled #1 and GPS plotted marked at N 31' 50.616 W 100'17.021. Walking east from this item, the top of a white Nike shoe was found. This shoe had the distinctive Nike "shoosh" on the side and AirMax across the back. This was photographed and marked as #2 and plotted at N 31'50.603 W 100'17.006. East of #2 is the edge of a mesquite brush out cropped. The scattered pieces of a Nike AirMax were located close to a thin mesquite. The state of degrade of the rubber sole caused it to brake up into pieces and spread out and separate from the upper. This was photographed, marked #3, and plotted at N 31'50.600 W 100'17.999. These three items were not far from a property fence line.

Watts then shown R/O the location of the camouflaged shorts. These shorts were a short distance north from item #1, but concealed from level view due to a slight drop in terrain and thick grass. The shorts were in a wad and appeared to be turned inside out with the white pockets facing up. The shorts appeared torn and had holes from possible insects or animal activity. The shorts were photographed as found and then laid out to see what brand the shorts were and if any other items could be located under or inside of the shorts. The printing on the shorts said MMA Elite. This was printed on several areas of the shorts, the built-in belt, and the inside tag. No other items were found with the shorts. This was photographed again to show the printing and tears to the shorts. It is marked as #4 and plotted at N 31'50.632 W 100'17.015.

R/O contacted Texas Ranger Tod Reed at 4:02pm and gave him information on what had been found. Ranger Reed advised that he would come out to the site. R/O went back to the individual

items and placed each in their own separate evidence bag, but left them in each of their own location so to give Ranger Reed a better visual on where each item was located in comparison to each other.

Ranger Reed arrived on scene and was shown the items and locations. Reed said that he would organize a day with other officers to conduct a wider search. All items were then collected and placed in the Coke County Sheriff's Office Evidence.

SUPPLEMENT 2-1-2022

On 2-01-2022, a search was conducted on the property with officers from the Coke County Sheriff's Office, DPS State Troopers, DPS CID, Texas Rangers, and Tim Smith, retired Sgt. San Bernadino CO SO. During this search, two DPS drones were used for arial video and pictures.

During this search, several dead animals remain were found under layers of grass. These remains could be identified as deer, hog, and skunk.

A DPS CID officer alerted Ranger Reed of a larger piece of bone. Reed went to the location and then contacted R/O about the discovery. R/O went to the location and saw what appeared to be the top cap of a human skull. This was located in a cactus. The top cap appeared to have marks on the edges from animal teeth. This was photographed and collected. Another bone piece that appeared to be a joint was located not far from the skull cap. It did not appear to be human due to size and shape, but was also collected to be tested.

No other human remains could be found. This could be due to time that the remains have been exposed since 08-2013, amount of foliage that had grown, and or animal activity.

On 2-09-2022, R/O and Ranger Reed delivered the bones to the University of North Texas Center for Human Identification. It was advised that it could take some time for any result to come back due to cases already pending ahead of this case.

A Forensic Anthropology Report came back on 3-30-2022. The report stated that the skull cap found was human and that the only damage to the cap was from rodents along the edges. This bone piece was being sent off for further DNA testing. The second bone fragment found was ruled out as being human.

TIMELINE OF EVENTS

August 9, 2013 (Friday) – Lawson's last known contact was at 1:19am via cell phone to his brother Kyle Lawson.

August 10, 2013 (Saturday) – Welfare Concern San Angelo – Fort Worth broadcasted via DPS Communications San Angelo

August 12, 2013 (Monday) – Approx. 3:30pm R/O scheduled to meet with volunteer search group and Ladessa Lofton/2 volunteers showed up, Ladessa Lofton did not.

August 12, 2013 (Monday) – Approx. 6:00pm R/O met with Texas Ranger Lt. Dwayne Goll from Midland and Chief Deputy Neal at the Bronte Office to discuss how to proceed with case, possible air search with DPS Helicopter on Tuesday August 13, 2013.

August 13, 2013 (Tuesday) R/O and Chief Deputy Neal met with Ladessa Lofton at the Bronte Office at approx. 10:30am. Explained to Ladessa Lofton what was happening with the case, and that DPS was scheduled to bring a helicopter over that afternoon to do a flyover.

August 13, 2013 (Tuesday) – Approx. 11:45am Ladessa Lofton came to the Sheriff's Office in Robert Lee to officially file a missing person's report and complete the necessary paperwork for entry into NCIC Missing Person's File. Faxed completed paperwork to DPS Communications for entry.

August 13, 2013 (Tuesday) – Approx. 3:00pm R/O met Texas Ranger Nick Hanna, Chief Deputy Neal and DPS Flight Crew at the Robert Lee Airport. Chief Deputy Neal and Ranger Hanna did a flyover of the area where Brandon Lawson's vehicle was located and reportedly last seen. Chief Deputy Neal called R/O on the phone and advised they were unable to locate subject Brandon Lawson.

August 14, 2013 (Wednesday) – Spoke with Ladessa Lofton by phone advised her nothing had been found as of yet, also as time allowed Sheriff's Office Deputies searched County roads and pastures in area of Live Oak Rd./U.S. HWY 277 also believe R/O spoke with Bradley Lawson (Brandon's Father) and advised nothing to report.

August 15, 2013 (Thursday) – Spoke with Ladessa Lofton and Brandon Lawson's Cousin (Cara Parish) and a spanish male subject (Matthew Delarosa) who advised they had more info on the case. R/O advised them that we appreciated the info and that if the Sheriff's Office had any new information we would contact them and that we had other cases to work also and we (S.O.) did not have time to focus on this one case.

August 16, 2013 (Friday) – At approx. 11:30am spoke to Bradley Lawson (Brandon's Father) and advised nothing to report but while out on patrol the Sheriff's Office units were still looking for Brandon Lawson.

August 17, 2013 (Saturday) – Spent approx. 2 hours 10:00am – Noon driving Wilkins Lane, Live Oak Rd and Ratliff Rd looking for any signs of Lawson. Nothing to report

August 18, 2013 (Sunday) – Ladessa Lofton called R/O at approx. 8:30am and advised a subject named Rudy , had called her on Friday August 16th and advised that he saw a subject matching Brandon Lawson's description on Friday August 9th walking on the highway between Miles and Ballinger. Ladessa Lofton said she called the Coke Co Sheriff's Office and spoke to Deputy Davis. Deputy Davis called Runnel's Co Sheriff's Office and Miles PD and advised them of this info. R/O has called the number for subject Rudy provided by Ladessa Lofton the following times with no answer.

Sunday Aug 18, 2013 – 8:35am – Left voicemail

Sunday Aug 18, 2013 – 1:00pm – Left voicemail

Sunday Aug 18, 2013 – 7:00pm – Left voicemail

Monday Aug 19, 2013 – 8:15am – Called Rudy – Left voicemail

Monday Aug 19, 2013 – 8:40am – Rudy Bautista – River Rd Miles, TX returned phone call and advised on Friday August 9, 2013 between 1:00pm – 2:00pm he observed a young male subject in bar ditch near Harriett on Hwy 67 that somewhat fit the description of Brandon Lawson. Rudy described him as a white male mid 20's wearing a yellow or blue shirt. Rudy had recently seen a poster for Brandon Lawson at his shop and believes the person he saw near Harriett could be the same person.

August 21, 2013 (Wednesday) – Acting on a tip searched three houses in Robert Lee for Brandon Lawson. Unable to locate – Tip was he had been seen in Robert Lee the previous weekend doing meth with local dooper.

August 22, 2013 (Thursday) – Approx. 2:30pm Cara Parish (cousin to Brandon Lawson) called asking if the Sheriff's Office knew if there had been any activity on Brandon's phone. R/O called Verizon 1-800 number and found that there had been no activity on Brandon's phone and called Cara Parish back and gave her this info.

August 22, 2013 (Thursday) 3:15pm Ladessa Lofton called and we talked about the case R/O advised her that the Sheriff's Office was still keeping an eye out for Brandon Lawson while on patrol. Ladessa Lofton advised she didn't think that R/O had handled this investigation very well and had violated her civil rights. R/O advised Ladessa Lofton that if that was the case she needed to talk to the Texas Rangers to start an investigation into the handling of the missing person case of Brandon Lawson.

August 23, 2013 (Friday) – Approx 10:00am Ladessa Lofton called the Sheriff's Office and R/O spoke with her on the phone. Ladessa was very distraught and crying R/O could barely understand her. Ladessa Lofton said that Coke County Sheriff's Office had not done the missing case of her husband right and that we had violated her civil rights. Ladessa Lofton also advised that R/O had given the newspaper (Owned by R/O wife Melinda McCutchen) confidential info to put in the Observer Enterprise. R/O told Ladessa Lofton that the same information was given to any reporter or news media that contacted R/O. Ladessa Lofton asked about getting a cadaver dog to search the area, R/O advised the Sheriff's Office had no experience with cadaver dogs but would contact the Texas Rangers to see if this is possible. Ladessa Lofton advised she was going to come to the Sheriff's Office with her kids and sit in the office until "something was done". R/O advised Ladessa Lofton that she could not just come to the Sheriff's Office and sit as we were a place of business and had other cases to work on.

August 23, 2013 (Friday) – Approx 10:30am R/O spoke with Ranger Hanna about the usefulness of using a cadaver dog, Ranger Hanna advised there was way too much ground to cover.

August 23, 2013 (Friday) – Approx 11:10am spoke with Ronny Perry – Search Dog Network
Ronny Perry advised Ladessa Lofton had contacted him about conducting a search in Coke County for Brandon Lawson. R/O advised him that an aerial search had already been conducted and at this time felt the search area was too large, but that R/O had his contact information and if things changed and we needed a search we would contact him.

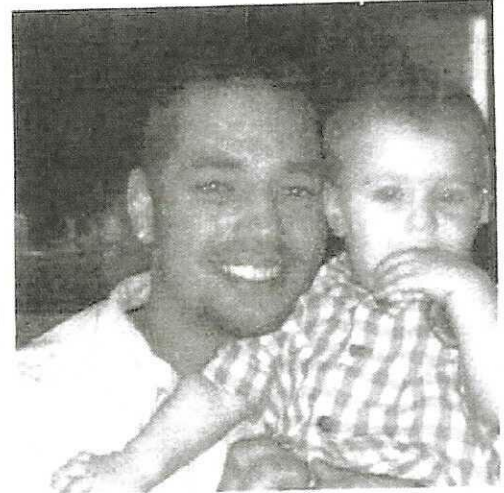

R/O made several attempts from Sunday August 11 2013 to Wednesday August 14th to make contact with Kyle Lawson regarding K.L. giving the S.O. a statement about his missing brother (Brandon Lawson). R/O was unable to make contact until Thursday August 15 2013. R/O asked K.L. to come to R.L. to meet with R/O to give a statement as he was the last person to talk to B.L. before he went voluntarily missing. K.L. advised he did not know when he would be able to get to R.L. as he was working a lot of hrs. and he also advised R/O that he had some warrants and did not have a valid DL. and was afraid if he came to R.L. S.O. would arrest him. R/O advised him to ask a family member to drive him over and that we could talk about the warrants but that ~~was~~ we needed his statement for the report to see if it would help locate his brother. K.L. advised he would get back with R/O about the statement.

Missing Person Brief - Brandon Lawson

- Brandon Mason Lawson has been missing since August 9 at around 1:00 a.m. He was last seen by his wife leaving his residence between 11:00 p.m. and 12:00 a.m. at 2322 Junius St., San Angelo, TX 76901.
- Brandon Lawson is 26 years old, 5' 10", 230 pounds, has brown hair and blue eyes, an arm sleeve tattoo on right arm and half sleeve left arm, tattoos on left calf, and a white scar above the knee.
- Brandon fought with his wife (common law, 10 years together), Ladessa Lofton, for most of the day. The fight started due to Brandon's drug use, he had been sober for a year and fell off the wagon.
- At about 10:45-11:00 p.m. the fight escalated (wife believes he was coming down off his meth high) and he started acting strange and accusing her of cheating. He was in panic mode and was saying there were people in the walls watching him, and then he left.
- Ladessa, concerned for the children, threatened to call police when he left.
- Family members assume he was heading to Fort Worth, citing a lack of family and friends in the San Angelo area.
- He took his keys, wallet, and cell phone. He was wearing a yellow shirt, Tap-Out camo shorts, white Nike Airmax shoes.
- Nearing Bronte on highway 277, Brandon reportedly dialed 911 at 12:50 a.m. because he had had an apparent accident and said something about hitting somebody and running out of gas, however the phone call was hardly intelligible.
- Lawson's truck revealed no damage upon inspection, and who or what Lawson claimed to have hit remains unknown.
- At 12:58 the Coke County Sheriff's office received a call that a vehicle was parked haphazard on the side of the road out on highway 277, thus posing a risk to oncoming traffic.
- Deputies responded to the call and arrived on the scene where Lawson's truck stood abandoned. At the same time, Kyle Lawson, Brandon's brother, appeared with a gas can and filled his brother's truck. Sheriff's Deputies asked Kyle if he was the one who had made the call, and Kyle stated that the vehicle was his brother's and that he must have stepped away. Kyle Lawson would gas it up and his brother would return to retrieve it. After this, the Deputies left the scene.
- When Deputies were on the scene, no mention was made concerning the potential whereabouts of Brandon Lawson. It wasn't until two to three days later that Kyle Lawson came forward and admitted to the Sheriff that his girlfriend had been on the phone with Brandon while Kyle was talking to the Deputies. Kyle reportedly went down the road and waited for the Sheriff's Deputies to leave, and went back and was calling out to Brandon.
- Lofton added that Kyle had driven up and down the highway looking for Brandon until 4:30 a.m., and claimed that a few of his co-workers had assisted in the search, however was unable to say whether or not anyone stepped out of the vehicle to search in the brush where Brandon had reported he was hiding.
- Brandon is said to have been 'hiding in the bushes because he was scared,' and, according to his brother's girlfriend, his last words were 'I'm bleeding, I'm bleeding.' Shortly thereafter, the cell phone cut out and contact was lost.
- That's the last anyone's seen or heard from Brandon, and no foul play is suspected.
- No one seems to know why Brandon Lawson was hiding out in the bushes, however an outstanding warrant from 2005 out of Johnson County for possession of a controlled substance aroused suspicion in the authorities and in Bronte residents.
- Since his disappearance, there have been four aerial searches, one put on by the Coke County Sheriff's Office and three privately-funded aerial charters.
- A grid search on foot covering about 3000 acres has not revealed any new clues. The search was conducted by between 20 and 25 people, including two or three Texas Rangers, Deputies from Tom Green County, Coke County, San Angelo Fire Department, DPS Highway Patrol, DPS Criminal Investigation, and a Search and Rescue Tracker.
- Lawson's girlfriend, Ladessa Lofton is convinced Brandon is dead. "Brandon would never do this to his family," she said of the father of her three children, "others would, but not him".
- Since his disappearance, Sheriff McCutchen has received three or four anonymous calls proclaiming to know the whereabouts of Lawson, and these vary from San Angelo to Fort Worth and in between.
- The Sheriff's Deputies have been keeping a look out when they make routine patrols, however up until now, no further information or evidence has surfaced.
- The Sheriff's Department does not suspect foul play in the case of Brandon Lawson, and he is currently listed as a missing person.

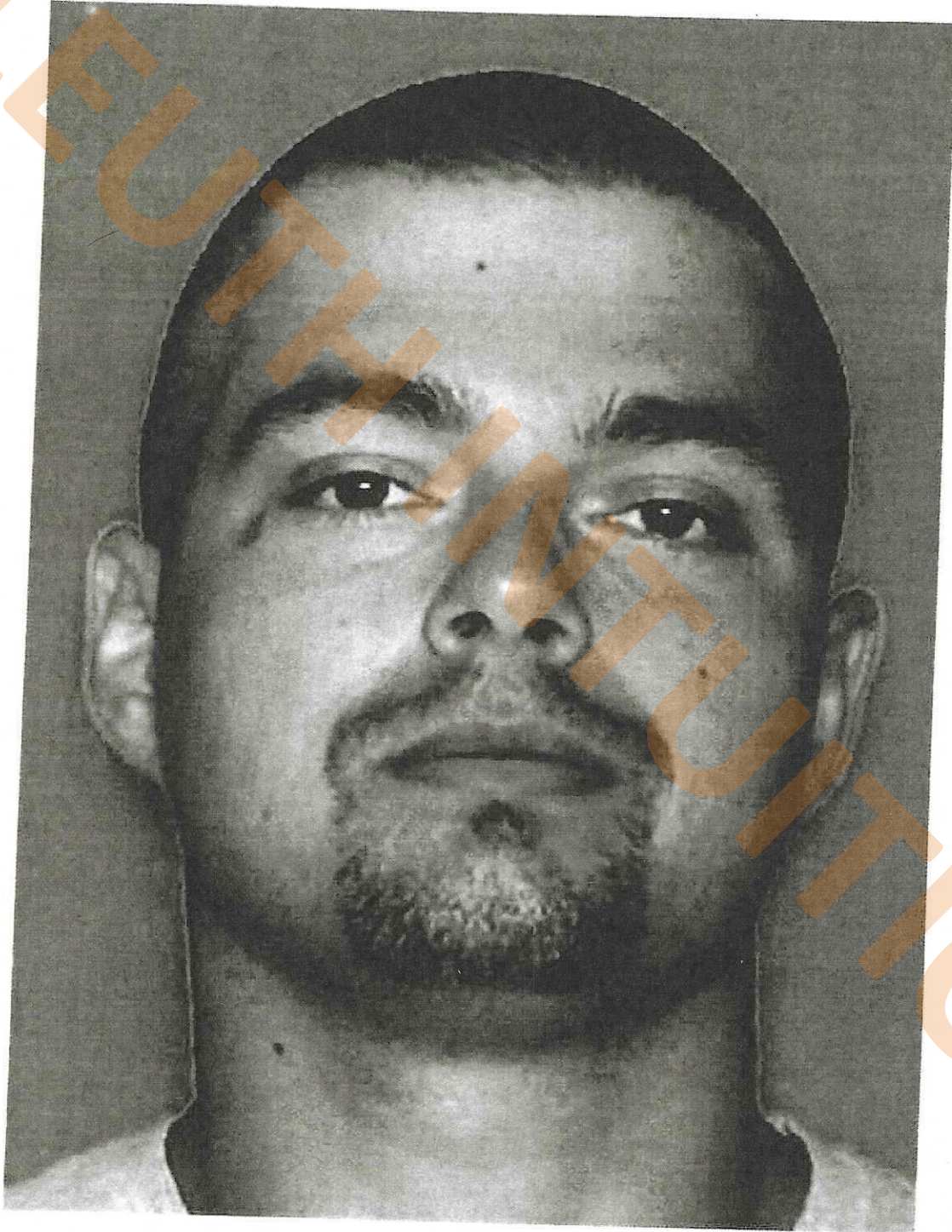

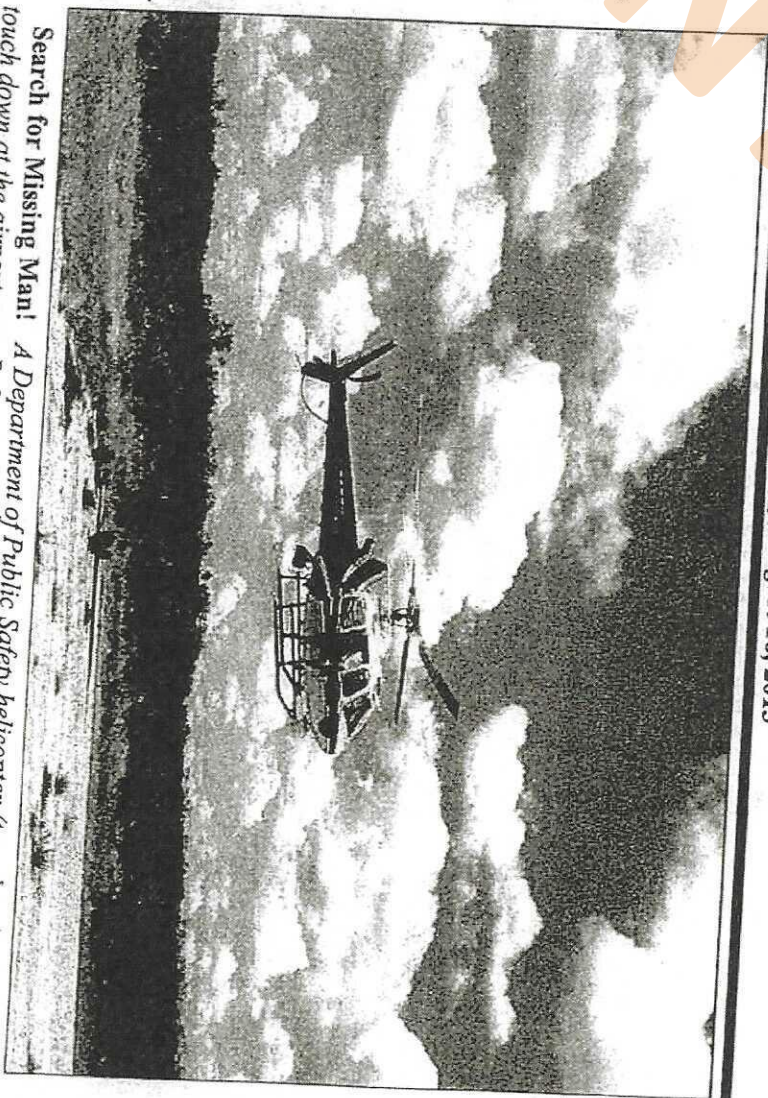

Search continues for man missing in Coke County

Brandon Lawson of San Angelo continues to be listed as missing through presstime Wednesday. What began as a simple stranded motorist call early Friday morning developed into much more over the weekend.

The original call from a passing motorist came into 911 and was passed onto the Coke County Sheriff's Office at 12:58 am Friday, August 9, 2013, reporting a stranded motorist. Just after 1 am, Chief Deputy Brandon Neal arrived at a disabled vehicle south of Bronte on Highway 277. Upon finding it abandoned with no keys inside, Deputy Neal turned on the vehicle's flashers and locked the doors.

Cell phone records revealed the missing man, Brandon Lawson, was speaking to his brother, Kyle Lawson, just after 1 am. During subsequent interviews with Kyle Lawson, he revealed he had been on the phone with his brother, Brandon, when Deputy Neal arrived at the disabled vehicle and was hiding in the brush watching Deputy Neal inspect his truck. Further investigation determined that Brandon Lawson had served stints in Texas Department of Correction facilities and currently has an outstanding felony warrant for Possession of a Controlled Substance with Intent to Distribute from Johnson County Sheriff's Office in Cleburne, Texas. The last contact with Brandon Lawson's phone was a text message at 1:19 am warning him about

police sent from a phone belonging to Kyle Lawson's girlfriend.

Due to the potential traffic hazard the abandoned vehicle posed, Deputy Neal chose to have it towed. At approximately 8:30 am Friday morning, Best Connection arrived at the abandoned vehicle on Highway 277 and towed it to their facility.

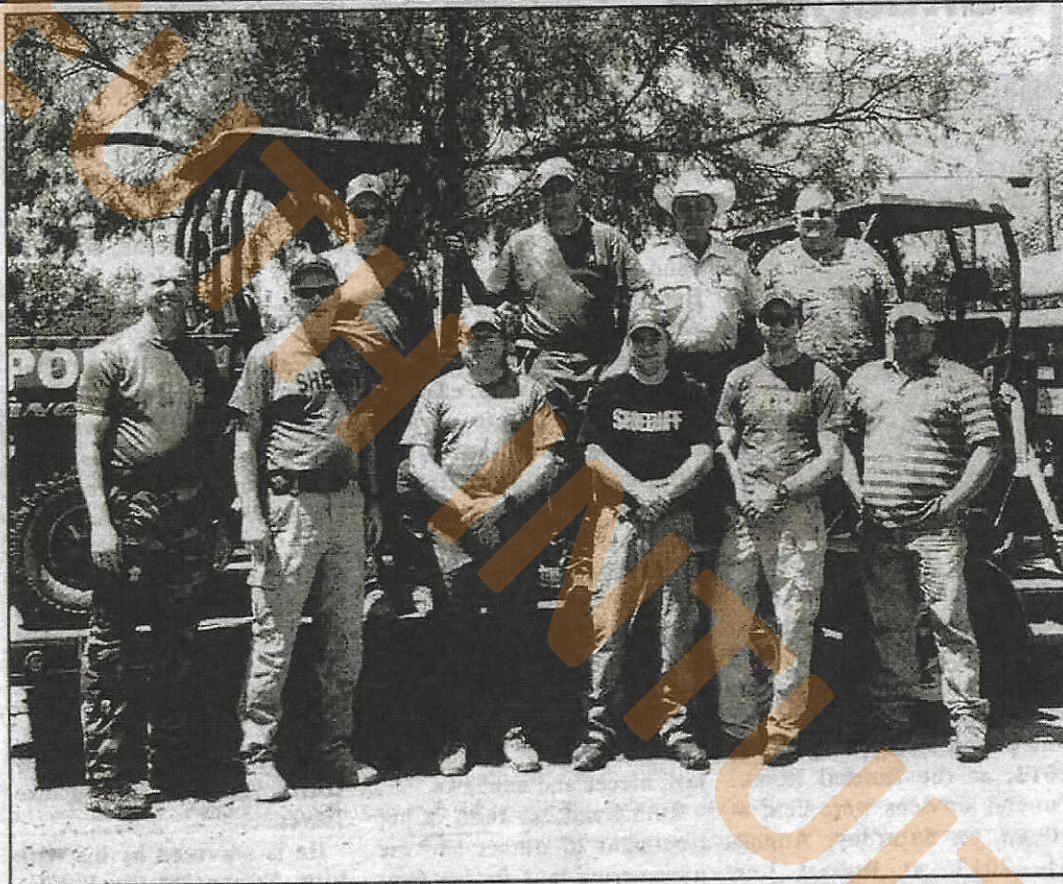
Sometime after 7 am Friday morning, Kyle Lawson purchased gas in a gas can from Stripes. The empty gas can was found in the back of the abandoned vehicle.

In the beginning, Coke County Sheriff's Office was only aware of an abandoned vehicle until family members began making contact with local law enforcement sometime later. As the investigation progressed, family members retracted original statements made to law enforcement, explaining they felt the need to protect Brandon from possible arrest.

On Sunday morning, August 11, 2013, a small group (approximately 15-20 people) accompanied Chief Deputy Neal in a search of the surrounding properties. According to Ladessa Lofton, the search came upon the place where it appeared Brandon Lawson watched Deputy Neal inspect his truck. Kyle Lawson did not assist with this search.

A Department of Public Safety helicopter assisted with a search of the area Tuesday afternoon. Unfortunately, the search was unsuccessful.

Friday, September 6, 2013



Search Conducted! Beginning early Thursday morning, August 29, 2013, law enforcement began a comprehensive and exhaustive search of over 2,500 acres surrounding the site where Brandon Lawson's truck was abandoned south of Bronte. Officers widened their search to include "likely lines of travel", such as river beds, etc., leading away from the main search area. Thursday's search turned up no sign of Brandon Lawson. Assisting with this search were members of the Coke County Sheriff's Office, Texas Rangers, San Angelo Fire Department, Tom Green County Sheriff's Office, Department of Public Safety Highway Patrol, Department of Public Safety Criminal Investigative Division, and a Search and Rescue Tracker. Carl Beal of Texana Ranch provided all terrain vehicles to assist those searching. Officers who participate in undercover investigations are not pictured.

The above search stems from an incident which occurred just before 1 am Friday, August 9, 2013. It began with a 911 call about a stranded motorist just south of Bronte on Highway 277. The driver was not at the vehicle when Chief Deputy Brandon Neal arrived just after 1 am. However at this time, investigation has revealed that Brandon Lawson was hiding in the brush (due to an outstanding felony warrant) watching Deputy Neal while speaking to his brother, Kyle Lawson, on his cell phone. According to Ladessa Lofton, no one has heard from Lawson since this time.

Law enforcement officials conducted an aerial search the following Tuesday afternoon, August 13. Although the helicopter flew just 30 feet above the ground and Lawson was reported to be wearing a yellow shirt at the time of his disappearance, nothing was seen of the missing man.

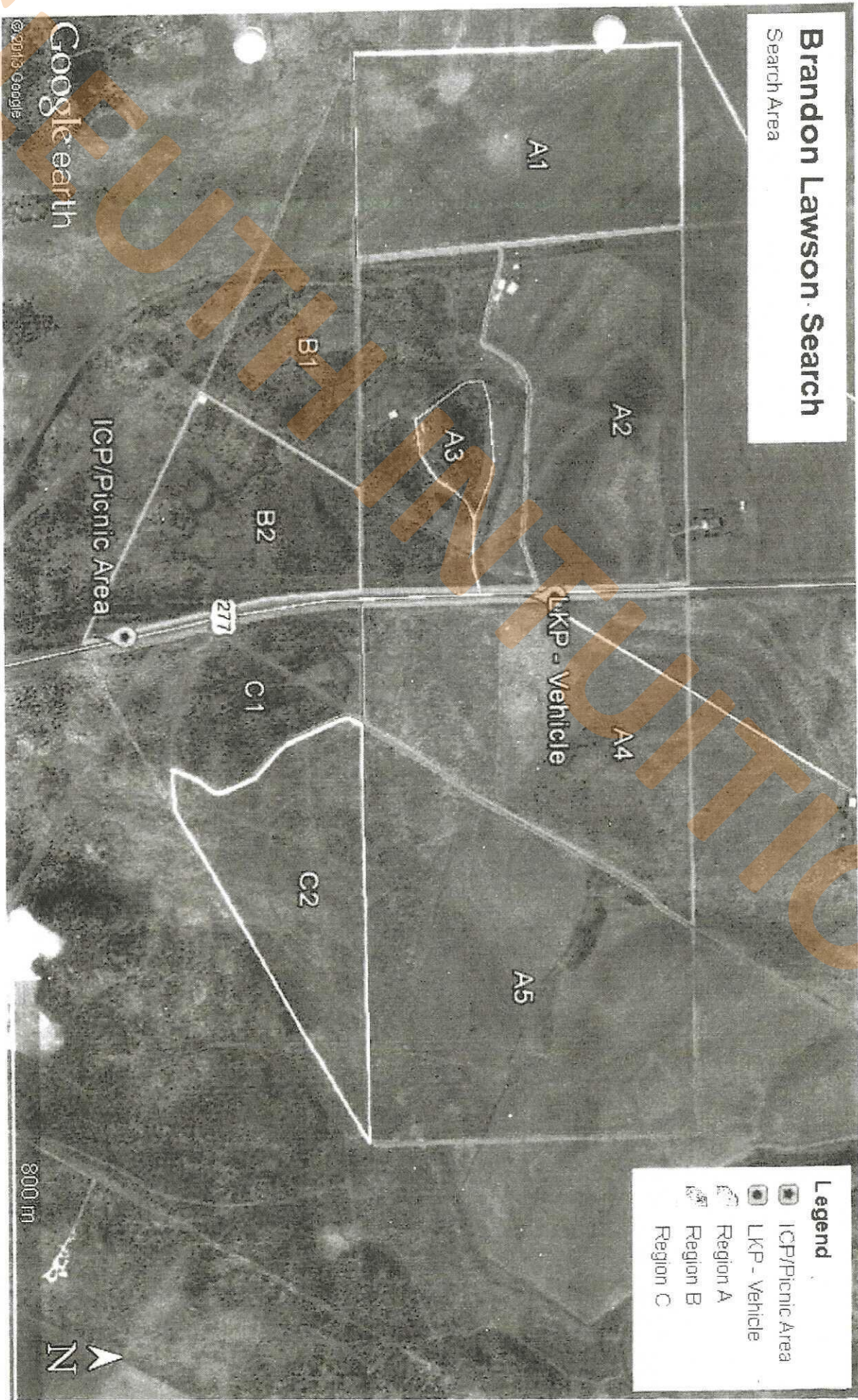
